It was also great to see all the kids help on the water station.

August 11th – The Gong Handicap – 1st Jared Olsen in the 7.6km and Una Laughton-Jones 1st in the 4.3km.

August 18th – Should have seen a few athletes head to the Anglesea relays but they were cancelled by AV. That meant a few of us could still contest the Graeme Quick Handicap which again saw Jared Olsen have another great run to finish 1st in the 6km and receive a gift voucher from Quicky and Una Laughton – Jones also run exceptional well to win the 3km. August 25th – The Gudgeon 10km championship – championship results are attached.

Track & Field Meeting Information

Hi BRAC Club reps,

Please find attached the 2018-19 season AV Shield Program of events for the BALLARAT Region (PDF).

This was approved by the BRAC Board and has been forwarded to AV.

Additional information to pass on to your members includes:

- The three Relay events – Swedish (100m, 300m, 200m, 400m) on Rd 1; Medley (200m, 200m, 400m, 800m) on Rd 2; Parlauf (2 x 10mins, Mixed teams, gender and age) on Rd 7 will all be Non-points scoring.
- Rd 4 will include a Non-points scoring 3000m event at the end of the program.
- Rd 8 will include Non-points scoring 3000m and 5000m events at the end of the program. These Mental Health Awareness runs will be open to registered and non-registered athletes to participate. A Gold coin entry will raise funds for Ballarat - HeadSpace.
- Evening (3:45pm) start in Rd 8 is due to the predicted warmer weather and to allow us to have an open invitation BBQ dinner after the competition.
- 9:00am start for Rd 9 is because there is no Little Athletics on that morning and to free up the afternoon.
- Rd 6 will have a Special Non-point scoring 100m event at the end of the program.
- Re-shuffled programs on Rounds 5, 6, 10 & 11 to mix up the 'normal' schedule of events.
- Twilight starts on Rounds 10, 11 & 12 due to the predicted warmer weather.

BRAC will continue to use the 'Open' scoring system that has been implemented over the previous three seasons. All athletes who participate in an event with OPEN specifications, can potentially score points for their age category and the Open age category for their club. Eg. Best 4 Track performances; Best 2 Field performances.

BRAC will incorporate an overall Relay aggregate award that will be calculated from cumulative relay results over the whole season.

Medals and recognition will be awarded at the end of the season to the Female and Male Champion athlete from each age category (Highest cumulative points).

Medals and recognition will be awarded at the end of the season to the Female and Male with the best performance throughout the season in each individual event.
